2. Under which processing activity are your personal data included and for what purposes will they be processed?

PROFESSIONAL CONTACTS IN THE TOURISM SECTOR.

In compliance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 on Personal Data Protection, your data will be processed for the following purposes:

Management of professional contacts in the tourism sector and sending information communications (newsletter) related to the Directorate-General's tourism promotion.

3. What is the legal basis for lawful processing?

GDPR 6. 1 a) the data subject has given consent to the processing of their personal data for one or more specific purposes.

GDPR 6. 1 e) processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the controller.

Law 1/1999, of 12 March, on Tourism Planning of the Madrid Region. Organic Law 3/2018, of 5 December, on Personal Data Protection and guarantee of digital rights (Article 19.3).

4. How to exercise your rights. What are your rights when you provide us with your data?

You may exercise, if you wish, the rights of access, rectification and erasure of data, as well as request the restriction of the processing of your personal data, object to the processing, request, where applicable, the portability of your data, as well as not to be subject to an individual decision based solely on automated processing, including profiling.

Under Law 39/2015, the GDPR and Organic Law 3/2018, you may exercise your rights via the [Electronic Register](#) or the [In-person Register](#) or in the places and forms provided for in Article 16.4 of Law 39/2015, preferably by using the request form [Exercise of rights in relation to personal data protection](#)

5. Processing that includes automated decisions, including profiling, with legal or similarly significant effects.

6. For how long will we keep your personal data?

The personal data provided will be kept for the following period:

Indefinite period.

The data will be kept for as long as necessary to fulfil the purpose for which they were collected and to determine any possible responsibilities that may arise from that purpose and from the processing of the data, applying the Madrid Region regulations on archives and documents. In the case of the newsletter, the affected data will be kept indefinitely for this purpose as long as the data subject does not request their erasure or exercise their right to object.

7. To which recipients will your data be disclosed?

No communications or transfers of personal data are foreseen.

9. Right to withdraw consent given for processing at any time.

Where processing is based on explicit consent, you have the right to withdraw consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.

You have the right to lodge a complaint with the Spanish Data Protection Agency www.aepd.es if you are not satisfied with the processing of your personal data.
